

YDUK was set up in 1998 as The Clive Project and now supports 120 families living with Young onset dementia in and around Oxfordshire. We also offer information and support to people across the country through our website, Facebook, twitter and via email and phone.

We first meet people at the Cognitive Disorders clinic where they are diagnosed. (or people can come directly to us or be referred at any time)

We provide relationship based individual practical and emotional support to the person with dementia and their families and offer them opportunities to meet other people in similar circumstances in a variety of settings.

We have walks, meet in cafes and pubs and have a monthly evening with live music and dancing. We know that people want to continue to live their lives to the full and everything we do is to support this.

With DEEP, we now have 3 groups of people with dementia who meeting monthly to socialise and also to influence local and national services.
